This is a quality rating and improvement system that provides framework for building strong early care and education systems within states. With its increased focus on data collection, QRIS can be a powerful policy tool to transform early childhood education. Some of the moving parts of this system are classroom management by receiving direct assistance from our coach, opportunities for stimulation and learning from experience, building positive relationships by expanding and adding more and more vocabulary between teachers and students and setting specific goals for each age group and attaining them by following the scales in both the Infant/Toddler Environment Rating Scale (ITERS) and the Early Childhood Environmental Rating Scales (ECERS). We are already seeing so many wonderful improvements and can't wait for what the future holds in early childcare.
